



CFI has broken down the number of Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) recipients in each House District and the average credit amount per district. The table below shows the average federal EITC amount in each district, how much the Colorado credit amount will be under current law, and how much the average amount would be if the Colorado credit was increased to 80% of the federal credit.
